The Maryland Leadership Seminar May 25 - 28, 2017
Mount St. Mary's University, Emmitsburg, MD

- Goals: 250 sophomore “ambassadors” representing their schools
 - Schools select a student with leadership abilities
 - \$195 is asked of the school, student’s parents or sponsorship
 - A few schools are able to send a second student at \$395
 - HOBY MD funds the rest of the \$450 per student
- Nearly 100 full time and day volunteers – no paid staff
- ¾ of our volunteers are HOBY alum: committee, facilitators, jr. facilitators (college), Team Alumni (high school) - backgrounds checked
- Donations and Gift-in-kind items cover expenses (room, board, buses, program supplies, snacks, university fees)
- 76 hours of leadership programming
 - Perspectives of leadership: personal, group & society
 - Motivational speakers
 - Hands-on Leadership Lab sessions & leadership style exercises
 - Panel on Volunteer Service, “What World Will You Inherit”
- Career Lunch
- Community Service projects
- Aluminum top pulls recycling for Johns Hopkins Children’s Cancer Ctr
- Social activities - Talent Show, Dance
- HOBY is a 501(c) (3) charitable organization
- 96.21% of fundraising supports the students

HOBY offers a four day seminar for high school sophomores, a one day seminar for freshmen and volunteer opportunities for alum.
